

The article informs of the new location of *Mycelis muralis* (L.) Dumort., Asteraceae, Magnoliophyta on the territory of Saratov oblast. It is noted that the found population (Balashov district, between Pady and Bolshoy Melik villages) is confined to the old homogeneous pine stands. In the researched area there are at least several thousand plants of the studied species. In many lots of the pine stands *M. muralis* is the dominant of the grass layer. It is stated that the studied European forest species is characterized by the man-induced expansion to the west as well as to the east towards the steppe zone; the species also actively outspreads to the homogeneous stands in the eastern part of the area.
