

The use of Licorice (*Glycyrrhiza* L., Fabaceae, Magnoliophyta) medicinal raw materials in Tibetan conventional medicine has been analyzed. The data on licorice usage expounded in classic papers on Tibetan medicine such as: "Chzhud-shek/shi", "Vaidurya-onbo", "Dzeytshar-Migchzhan", "Big Agin Jordania", "Ontsar-Gadon-Der-Dzod" has been provided. It is stated that licorice roots and rootstocks are used to treat lungs and blood vessels diseases, toxicosis, complicated diseases of digestive organs, etc.; they are useful at an early and old age. Formulas/receipts of some Tibetan herbal teas which include licorice are provided. It has been noted that receipts with licorice are suitable for wide range of diseases treatment: for colic pain, headache, swellings, cardiac and respiratory failure, paralysis, syphilis, impotency, etc. The composition of some receipts with licorice is not transcribed.
